Patient Diagnostic Colonoscopy Hospital Information

Hospital Arrival: If your appointment is after 8:30 A.M., you must arrive and register in the Admitting Department 60-90 minutes before your scheduled colonoscopy. If your appointment is before 8:30 A.M., you must arrive and register in the Admitting Department at 7:00 A.M. The colonoscopy will take 20-30 minutes to perform, and you need to stay 30 minutes to 1 hour after it is over. Plan to be at the hospital for 1.5 to 3 hours from start to finish.

Hospital Checklist:

☐ Bring a list of current medications.
☐ Bring your ostomy supplies if you have an ostomy.
\square Bring your most recent glucose reading if you have diabetes.
☐ Bring your CPAP, Bi-level machine or dental device for sleep if you use one and have IV
sedation.
☐ Bring a translator if you do not understand or speak English.
\square Bring your PEI Health Card or proof of substitute medical insurance plan. If you do not have
these, bring another form of personal ID.
☑ Do not wear any jewelry, e.g. rings, watches, earrings, bracelets, or necklaces.
☑ Do not bring any valuables.
