

## Patient Diagnostic Colonoscopy Hospital Information

**Hospital Arrival:** If your appointment is **after** 8:30 A.M., you must arrive and register in the **Admitting Department 60-90 minutes before** your scheduled colonoscopy. If your appointment is **before** 8:30 A.M., you must arrive and register in the **Admitting Department at 7:00 A.M.** The colonoscopy will take 20-30 minutes to perform, and you need to stay 30 minutes to 1 hour after it is over. Plan to be at the hospital for **1.5 to 3 hours** from start to finish.

### **Hospital Checklist:**

- Bring a list of current medications.
- Bring your ostomy supplies if you have an ostomy.
- Bring your most recent glucose reading if you have diabetes.
- Bring your CPAP, Bi-level machine or dental device for sleep if you use one and have IV sedation.
- Bring a translator if you do not understand or speak English.
- Bring your PEI Health Card or proof of substitute medical insurance plan. If you do not have these, bring another form of personal ID.
- Do not wear** any jewelry, e.g. rings, watches, earrings, bracelets, or necklaces.
- Do not bring** any valuables.
