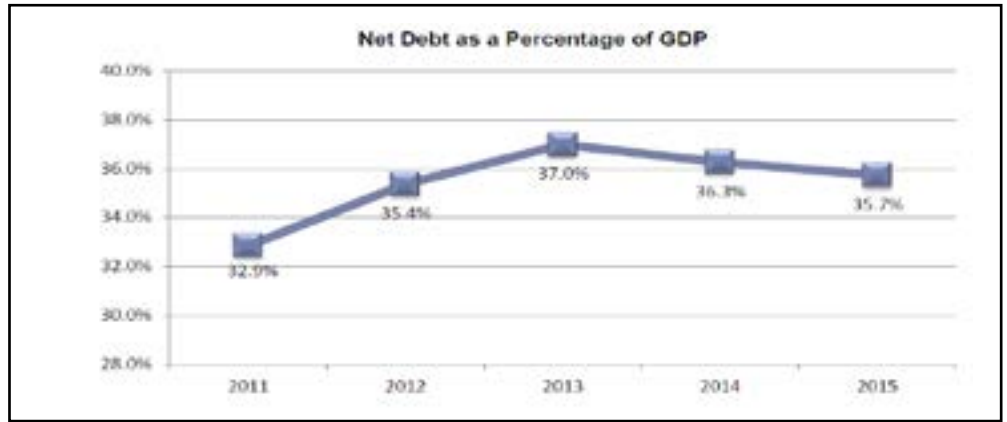
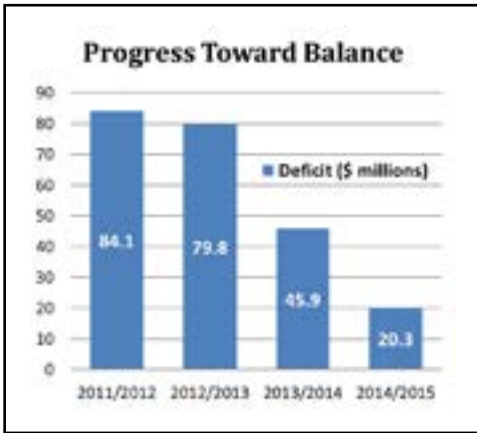


Prince Edward Island saw the highest growth in average weekly earnings in the past year, in all provinces.

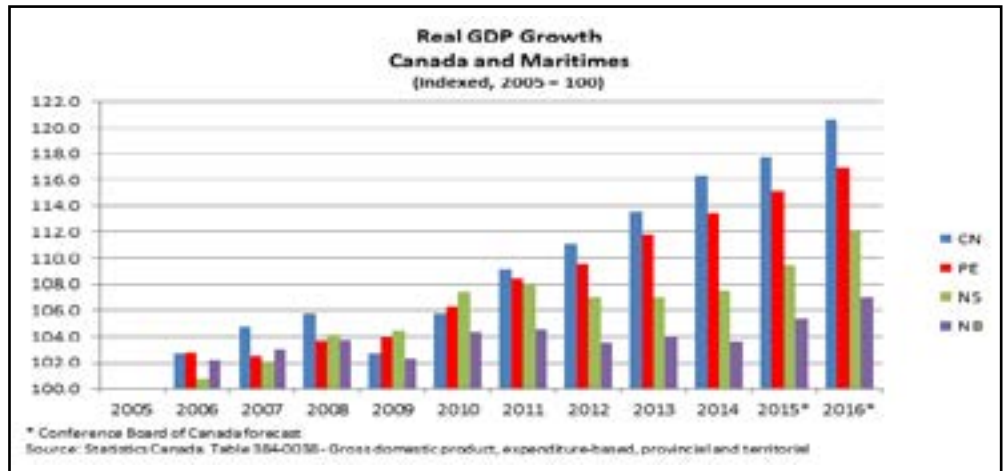


Prince Edward Island has the strongest performance in exports, and third highest in manufacturing shipments amongst all provinces, as of Oct/Nov 2015.

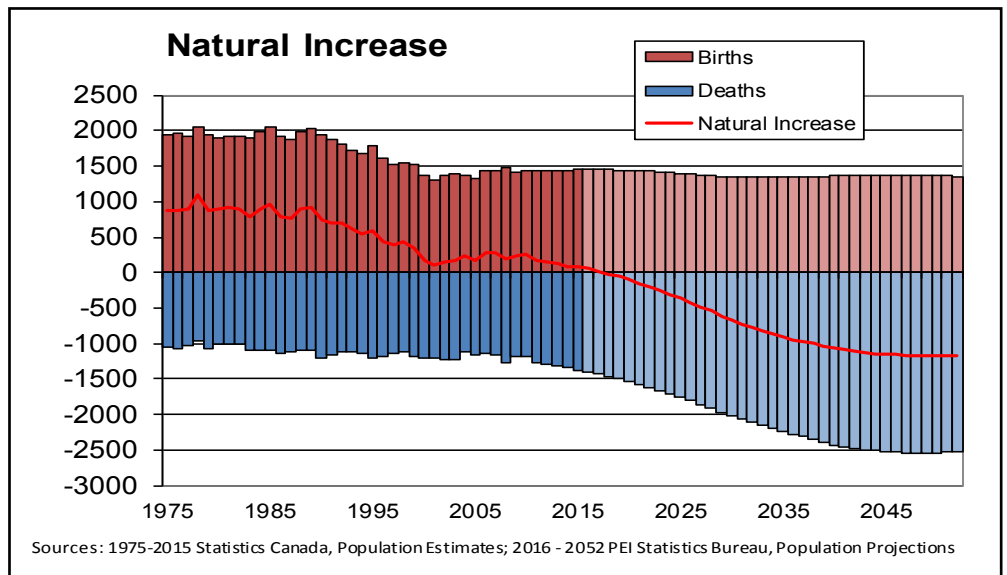
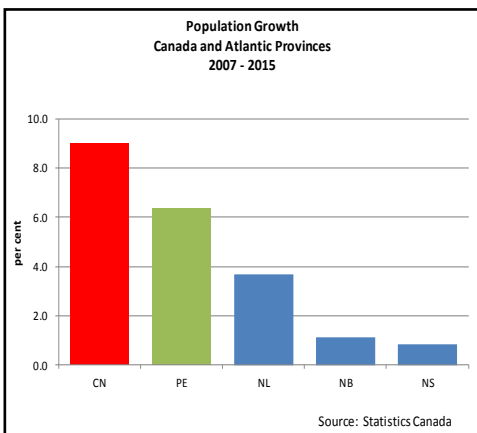




With a return to fiscal balance in 2016/17 and continued economic growth, the debt to GDP ratio will continue on a downward trend.
