



BACK TO SCHOOL PLAN 2020

The arrival and departure of students will be staggered. This may cause delays in transportation and at the beginning/end of the school day.

RIDING THE BUS

- Practice physical distancing at bus stops.
- Masks are strongly recommended if physical distancing is not possible
- Wash hands before getting on the bus and after getting off the bus
- Face forward in your seat
- Family members are encouraged to sit together where possible
- Students will remain on buses until directed by school staff to depart and will be guided to the appropriate door
- Where possible, bus routes will be re-routed to minimize ridership and bus transfers
- Additional bus drivers and buses will be added to the system to help reduce ridership and transfers
- Buses will have enhanced cleaning protocols including cleaning and sanitizing seats and commonly touched surfaces following morning and afternoon shifts

WHERE POSSIBLE, WALKING, BIKING AND ALTERNATIVE MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION ARE ENCOURAGED



For students who walk to school or arrive by car, they will be provided a designated time frame to arrive. Upon arrival, they will be directed to the appropriate door. Parents will be asked to adhere to the drop-off time frames designated by each school.

Parents will not be permitted to leave their vehicles during drop-offs, enter schools with their children during arrival or walk their children to the doors.
