Evaluation Criteria for Project Applications

Applications are evaluated on a case-by-case basis and must demonstrate a need for the funds

requested.

The Wildlife Conservation Fund Committee evaluates applications based largely on the following:

projects must demonstrate a direct benefit to Island wildlife and/or wildlife habitat;

•presence of matching funds (in-kind and cash) in the budget;

•achievable project that can be completed and a final report submitted by December 31, 2017;

track record of the applicant

Note: For research projects, applicants must attach the hypothesis, methodology, and a description of

any practical applications resulting from the research

The PEI WCF Committee will not consider applications from groups whose 2016 final reports were more

than two weeks late or who have failed to report in previous years.
