I/We acknowledge and agree that:

1. The property and dwelling that is the subject of this application under the **efficiencyPEI** Winter Warming Program is registered with the Taxation and Property Records Division of the PEI Department of Finance in my/our name or if a rental property that I/We pay the total heating bills.
2. The Heating System Tune-up Voucher supplied under the **efficiencyPEI** Winter Warming Program is non-transferable and has no cash value.
3. Clients who receive the **efficiencyPEI** Winter Warming program shall be ineligible to apply for the program again for a period of not less than 5 years for the property subject to the application.
4. I/We are completely responsible for the quality and adequacy of any upgrades approved for rebates or services provided, which includes the responsibility for ensuring compliance with any and all applicable regulatory requirements, including any building code, electrical code, safety code, municipal bylaw or provincial or federal regulation or statute, and in no event shall the Government of PEI be liable to anyone in whole or in part for the upgrades or any part of the upgrades, including any loss or claim by anyone that may result from the upgrades.
5. The smart power bar provided to you under the **efficiencyPEI** Home Energy Low-income Program must be installed by you. It is important to read and follow all instructions included with the smart power bar before use. Some key points from the instructions are also outlined below for extra emphasis. **We recommend connecting any home theater media center computers, or appliances containing a hard drive into the 'Always On' socket. We recommend connecting home theater projection equipment which requires a cool down period to the 'Always On' socket. This will prevent damage to, and extend the life of, your home theater projection lamps.**

Why Air Sealing Matters



Controlling air leakage has many benefits to you and your home:

- Saving money on heating costs
- Greater comfort with fewer cold spots and drafts
- Less moisture infiltration to home, protecting building materials from rot
- Quieter home and improved air quality by reducing the amount of noise and dust entering the house

Smart Power Bars:

Smart power bars reduces electricity consumption by switching off power to devices connected to its power saving sockets when they are not in use, eliminating standby power losses. The electricity savings for using a smart power bar with at least three devices connected to the power saving sockets is up to \$75.00 per year!

What Audio Visual Equipment Can Be Used With a smart power bar?

Always On socket

- Audio Visual (AV) equipment that requires constant power for timers, program guides and recording features, such as DVD recorders, pay TV and PVR units, cable boxes, hard drives, game consoles or digital receivers
- Certain home theater projectors that require a cool down period, including rear projection televisions
- Power Saver sockets - will be automatically switched off
- Televisions without in-built hard drives
- Home theater speaker systems
- Sound bars
- CD, DVD, and Blu-ray players
- Amplifiers
- Lamps

Winter Warming

Low-income clients with a total household income of \$50,000 or less, are eligible to have a Winter Warming tradesperson complete a comprehensive air-sealing (caulking, weather-stripping, sealing gaskets, etc....) free of charge.

Other features of the Winter Warming program include:

- installation of a programmable thermostat
- a low-flow showerhead
- a voucher for a free heating system cleaning (up to \$115 value)
- a quantity of ENERGY STAR® LED light bulbs
- a smart power bar (minimum 3 pieces of electronics must be available to be plugged into power bar)

These are simple measures that can have a big impact on the amount of heat lost in your home, saving you money.

The results will vary depending on the size of your home, the current condition of your home and the type of heating system you have—installing a programmable thermostat can save up to \$250 per year in heating costs; and sealing air leaks with caulking and weather-stripping on windows and doors, sealing electrical outlets, and weather-stripping your attic hatch can save as much as \$650 per year in heating costs.
